The design should be created on the official form. Students will also need to have AAEA parent/guardian permission form.

The winning student will be asked to write a brief statement as to why art is important in their life and student will be photographed with their flag design.

The winning design will be reinterpreted into a fabric flag that will be sent to Washington D.C. to fly at the capital during the Youth Art Month Celebration, as well as the National Art Education Association Convention in March.

The winning student will also receive a box of art supplies from the Council of Art Education, Inc.

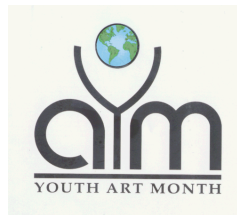
